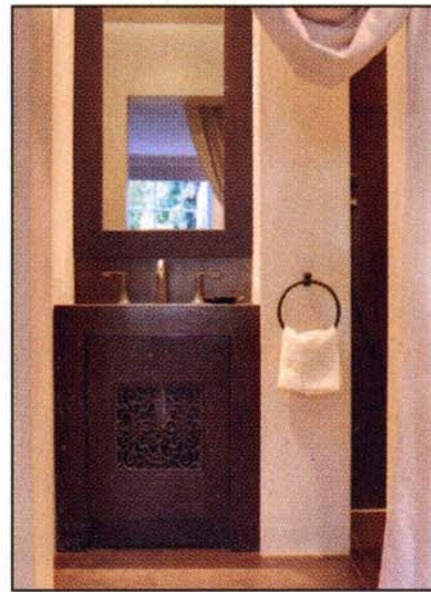


MICHELLE PABARCIUS - DESIGN SOLUTIONS



What Michelle says:

"I pushed the boundaries with this design and used things that would not normally be considered for such a small space, such as large dark tiles, and dividing the narrow floor space up with different coloured tiles. I squeezed out space architecturally. These elements helped me to create the unique spa ambience that was desired by the client and spaciousness that you would not have expected."

The brief:

Michelle had previously worked on this 170-year-old home over a period of several years, having already designed the architectural elements in the adjacent rooms of this shower area. A leak meant this room, an en suite to a guest bedroom, needed stripping right back to the brickwork and starting again. The brief was to create a new en-suite wet room with a contemporary spa feel that would complement the adjacent bedroom. Uniquely, the client also wanted to add a wine cellar to the space and have a hand shower so it could also be used to bathe the dog.
